Passionate about public health, I am a general physician with over 3 years of experience working with both local & international organizations like BRAC, Save the Children and ICRC. At present, I am working at the Medical Center of BRAC University Residential Campus in a leading role. I also have experience leading a team of medical professionals, including nurses, medical assistants, and community health workers at Alikadam Upazilla Health Complex during the pandemic, which was a COVID project implemented by **Gram Unnayan Sangathan (GRAUS)** in collaboration with **Save the Children**. That time, we supported the health complex with medicines and instruments, facilitated IPC & COVID management training for the doctors and staff. We also arranged health education programs for the community members and served almost 15,000 patients until the project ended. This specific project inspired me and increased my interest in public health specifically in the field of Epidemiology. All these experiences have also raised critical questions and challenges which drive me to improve my skills and knowledge through BRAC University's MPH programme to effectively address global health issues.
